

The Great Park Pursuit Safari Hats

An adventure is better when you play the part! Grab some simple items around the house and make a safari hat before you head-out on your Great Park Pursuit adventure!

Materials Needed:

- paper plates (one per person)
- paper bowl (one per person)
- string
- markers or crayons



Start by cutting a large hole in the center of each paper plate. the hole should be one inch smaller than the paper bowl. Slide the bowl inside the hole and secure the two together with tape or glue.



Using a paper punch, make a small hole on either side of the hat. Tie a string through each hole to create a chin strap.

Using markers, crayons, stickers, glitter, etc. decorate your safari hats!



Grab your safari hats (and your toilet paper binoculars... another GPP activity) and head out on your Great Park Pursuit adventure.
