

South Sioux City Scenic Park

park information:

The first 15 acres of Scenic Park was donated to South Sioux City by the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission in 1967 after a public boat ramp was constructed by the Missouri River. From there we have added an outdoor pool and a 15-site campground that we have added onto eight times. This beautiful park today is 159 acres.

Scenic Park is home to a YMCA, an outdoor pool, a 135-site year-round campground, five ball fields, 15 soccer fields and a drive-in theater. Many different trails go through this park and all are connected to 14 miles of trails running all the way around the city of South Sioux. On an average weekend, the park sees approximately 30,000 visitors coming to enjoy all the activities.

Scenic Park was chosen as a "Great Places Nebraska" winner this year.

camping amenities: 135 RV camp sites, 6 tent sites and 4 primitive cabins.

activities: Find fun things to do at www.negpp.org under "Activities."

directions: From Interstate 29 take exit 48 from the south and exit 49 from the north. Take the bridge to Nebraska. At the light on the Nebraska side, take a left on Riverview, go 8 blocks and the campground is on the left.



clue: Bike from the campground (bikes are available to borrow), riding the trail that Lewis and Clark followed.

distance: From Cabin #1 go east 4,013 feet to the intersection of the trails and you will not even leave Scenic Park.

surface: The trail is all concrete.
